Dear Mother Columba:

The stained glass windows which were made for you in 1924 are made of mouth blown antique glass. This glass is blown into a sausage shape balloon. The two ends are cut away resulting in a cylinder; the cylinder is cut lengthwise and flattened out into a sheet. By this process the glass varies in thicknesses and in texture throughout its area and does much to give it the charm which the old windows hade. Your windows were made of new glass fabricated in England, Germany and France.

I hope that this answers your questions sufficiently. If not please write again.
